ABSTRACTS AND PAPERS

Authors are invited to submit abstracts (250-300 words, Times New Roman, 12 pts) in electronic form until 15.11.2009. Full names of the authors, their titles, affiliation, full address (postal and e-mail) as well as contact telephone numbers must be on the same page with the abstract text. Abstracts and papers should be prepared as MS Word and PDF documents. Both files (MS Word and PDF) should be submitted together, to the conference e-mail address: gnp@ac.me. The number of pages of full paper is limited to six. Detailed instruction for paper preparation must be respected in whole. The instruction with template in electronic form will be sent to the authors together with notification about the abstract acceptance. It is also available at www.gnp.ac.me.

Papers accepted and submitted in time (by 10.01.2010) will be published in GNP 2010 Proceedings. Registration fee payment must be received in order the paper to be included in the conference proceedings.

PAPER PRESENTATION

The presentations will be made either orally or by poster. Authors should choose the presentation method and inform Organising Committee by 20.01.2010. Further instructions on oral presentation duration and poster size will be available after 30.01.2010.
