- Climate and environment

To illustrate the topic and deepen understanding, we will also provide excursions and a plenary session. A special highlight will be the "open marketplace" where everybody will get a chance to present the week's results and findings to the public.

The final feedback session includes an election, crowning next year's host nation for the EuroEnviro 2011.
