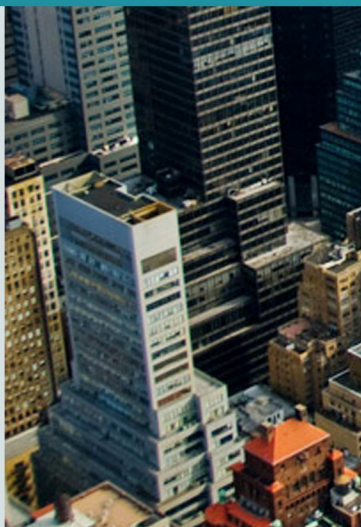

Conference Synopsis and Objectives

Selected Submission - Publication
