Info

Organized by University of Maribor, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Transportation Engineering and Architecture, the 1st edition of SSRID 2019 Summer School is designed to provide a clear introduction to concept of Sustainable Safe Road Infrastructure Design.

The purposes of the Summer School

- *to offer a unique course on Sustainable Safe Road Infrastructure Design,*
- *students get acquainted with the achievements of science and profession and novelties in the field of Road Safety in the EU,*
- *students solve cases of dangerous road infrastructure (roads, road sections, intersections, interchanges, down town areas...) from their surroundings and propose measures to improve the situation or eliminate problems,*
- *student's work at the summer school will be directed and supported with the help of Slovenian professors and experts in this field.*

Content of the Summer School

- *Lectures and excursions*
- *Workshops: Students work on their own projects (from their surroundings)**
- *Social Events*

*Explanation:

Three students from each faculty are chosen by their faculties. Students have a **working mentor**, a professor from their faculty.

The faculties need to send the proposal of their projects **no later than 15th May 2019** to the summer school organizer (e-mail: vlasta.rodosek@um.si).

The proposal should be present/written in the Application form.

Summer School Committee will reviewed proposal and accept or reject it. Applicants will receive information about proposal acceptance/rejection latest on 30th June 2019.

Who can participate?

All faculties of civil and transportation engineering from WB6 countries.

Registration Fee

There is no registration fee for students and working mentors.

The organizer will cover expenses of accommodation, coffee breaks, light lunches, excursions and social events for students, working mentors need to cover the costs of their accommodation.

Travel expenses are paid by the participants as well as their other expenses.
