### Conference Sessions

The conference will feature four thematic sessions:

1. **Architecture and Preservation** – addressing architectural heritage, preservation techniques, and conservation challenges.
2. **Engineering aspects of built heritage preservation** - focusing on structural issues and engineering solutions for heritage buildings
3. **Excavation, Legislation, and Management** – covering excavation methodologies, heritage law, and practical management of historical sites
4. **Ethic aspects of built heritage** in humanities and urban studies – exploring cultural, historical, and urban perspectives on heritage preservation and presentation

- **Abstracts:** Authors are invited to submit abstracts of up to **300 words**, including title, authors’ names, affiliations, and contact information.
- **Language:** Submissions are accepted in **English**.
- **Deadline for Abstract Submission:** ~~30th of April~~ 12<sup>th</sup> of May
- **Notification of Acceptance:** ~~5th of May~~ 17<sup>th</sup> of May
- **Full Paper Submission:** 30th of June
