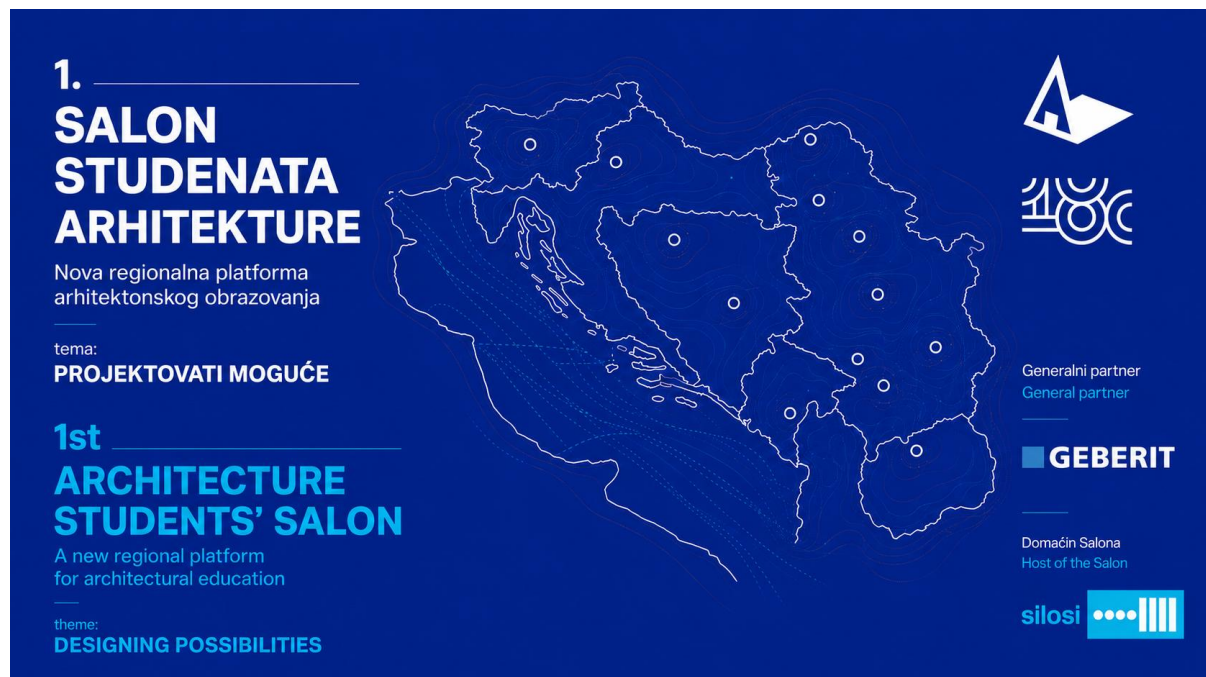




GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY BOARD AND THE JURY

Implementation Timeline of the 1st Student Architecture Salon

7 August 2026

PUBLIC CALL LAUNCH

The official **Call for Participation** for the **1st Student Architecture Salon** will be published on the website of the **University of Belgrade – Faculty of Architecture** and through the Salon's official communication channels.

Role of the Advisory Board and Jury Members

During the first week following the launch of the Call, all members of the Advisory Board and the Jury are kindly invited to promote and disseminate the Call through:

- the official websites of their institutions;
- institutional and personal social media channels;
- student mailing lists and communication platforms;
- other communication channels available within their schools.

Objective: To ensure the widest possible visibility of the Call across all participating schools of architecture.

7 August – 17 September 2026

OPEN CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Students prepare and submit their projects in accordance with the Call for Participation and the submission guidelines.

18–20 September 2026

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF SUBMISSIONS

The Organising Committee and the Technical Secretary will review all submissions to verify:

- the completeness of the application materials;
- compliance with the submission requirements;
- correct allocation to the appropriate category;
- technical quality and accessibility of the submitted files.

Only submissions that fully comply with the Call requirements will proceed to the Jury evaluation stage.

20 September 2026

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SELECTED PROJECTS

The official list of projects accepted for exhibition at the **1st Student Architecture Salon** will be published.

On the same day, all Jury members will receive:

- the complete catalogue of selected projects;
 - a systematic overview of submissions organised by category;
 - an individual evaluation form;
 - detailed evaluation guidelines.
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21–30 September 2026

INDIVIDUAL JURY EVALUATION

Each Jury member independently reviews all selected submissions.

Projects are evaluated using a **five-point scale (1–5)** according to the established evaluation criteria.

Completed evaluation forms are submitted to the Technical Secretary.

30 September – 1 October 2026

COMPILATION OF EVALUATION RESULTS

The Technical Secretary and the Organising Committee will:

- compile all individual evaluations;
- prepare consolidated evaluation results;
- identify the highest-ranked projects within each category;
- prepare a shortlist for the final Jury session.

This process ensures that the final Jury meeting focuses on the discussion of the highest-quality submissions rather than the complete body of selected works.

2 October 2026

FINAL JURY SESSION

Gaia Gallery, Silosi 3, Port of Belgrade

During the final session, the Jury will review the shortlisted projects and make final decisions regarding:

- the **Grand Prize of the Student Architecture Salon**;
- category awards;
- Special Mentions;
- Commendations.

The session concludes with the formal adoption of the official Jury Report.

3 October 2026

OPENING OF THE SALON

Official opening ceremony of the **1st Student Architecture Salon**.

Announcement of the recipients of the **Grand Prize**, Awards, Special Mentions and Commendations.

ROLE OF THE ADVISORY BOARD

The Advisory Board plays an important role in promoting the Salon and strengthening its international visibility.

Throughout the implementation of the Salon, members of the Advisory Board are invited to:

- promote the Salon within their institutions;
- participate in the opening ceremony and accompanying programme, where possible;
- contribute to the further development of the regional network of schools of architecture and support the preparation of future editions of the Student Architecture Salon.
