Diploma does not suffice for admission to the professional body for Architects. An extra 120 ECTS are required for professionals to be admitted to the *Board*, i.e., a total of 300 ECTS, corresponding to 5 academic years and a Master's degree.

Applications for and admissions to Integrated Masters programmes conform to regulations applicable to the first study cycle.

The Master in Architecture is vertically structured holding a common core of courses on Drawing, Architectural Theory and History, Architectural Design and Urban Studies. The programme has a transversal logic which relates the subjects of each year to a theme that is studied within the subject perspective. The study is a full-time five academic year degree leading to a master thesis.

MSc in Spatial Planning and Urban Project

The second study cycle (MSc in Spatial Planning and Urban Project) is comprised of 90 to 120 ECTS, lasting for a minimum of three or four semesters. Exceptionally, it can be comprised of 60 ECTS and last for two semesters, for students with stable professional experiences, consolidated internationally in the Master's field of expertise. The second study cycle includes:

- a specialization programme, comprised of an organized set of courses designated as Master"s programme and corresponding to a minimum of 50% of the cycle"s credits;

- an original scientific dissertation or project work, expressly conceived for the programme, Students who do not complete their dissertation but who complete the programme curriculum will be issued a Master"s programme Diploma (which does not, however, confer a Master"s degree).

Special Courses:

The University has two specialization courses. One, called "*Especialiazação em Edificação e Projeto Urbano*" is a closed programme with a Brazilian cooperation. The Second is the **Advanced Studies in Architectural Heritage**, a 1-year programme in a postgraduate level, offering 45 ECTS.

PhD Programme

The Doctoral Programme in

Architecture, is a 3rd cycle study which awards students with a doctoral degree in Architecture and encompasses: a) writing an original thesis which has to be specially written for this purpose and be adequate for students' field of knowledge and specialized area;

b) the completion of course units on Theory, Urban Planning and Living Space designed for investigation, being called Doctoral Programme and awarding students with a Doctoral Programme Diploma.
